

Privacy Policy

This Statement of Privacy applies to Omni Childhood Center's ("Omni's") billing modules, which include Omni Online 2.0 (Omni's billing app) and Omni Provider Portal (Omni's billing website) – collectively, "Billing Modules" – and governs data collection and usage. By using Omni's Billing Modules, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

Omni is the sole owner of the information collected on this site. We will not sell or rent this information to anyone.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Omni. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, app version, device id, device name and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, to provide customer support, and to provide general statistics regarding use of Omni's Billing Modules. Omni may share data with trusted partners to help perform these functions. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Omni, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Omni may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Omni or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Omni; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Omni or the public.

Security of your Personal Information

Omni secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. Omni uses the following methods for this purpose:

-SSL Protocol

We strive to take appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to or alteration of your personal information. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet or any wireless network can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect your personal information, you acknowledge that: (a) there are security and privacy limitations inherent to the Internet which are beyond our control; and (b) security, integrity, and privacy of any and all information and data exchanged between you and us through Omni's Billing Modules cannot be guaranteed.

Children under Thirteen

Omni does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.

External Data Storage Sites

We may store your data on servers provided by third party hosting vendors with whom we have contracted.

We may provide you additional forms of notification about significant changes in the way we treat personal information, via email or as otherwise appropriate under the circumstances.
